# USGA Rules of Golf and the following rules govern all play 

1. Cart Paths: Relief is granted for all cart paths and roads on the golf course.
2. No Play Zones:
a. Staked Trees: If such a tree interferes with the player's stance or area of intended swing, the ball must be lifted, without penalty, and dropped in accordance with the procedure prescribed in Rule 16.1. b. Flower Beds: Same as above, but drop procedure for both Rule 16.1 and 17.1 apply.
3. Red Penalty Areas: (Model Local Rule B-2) Player may drop a ball on the opposite side within two club lengths, no nearer to the hole than a reference point that is equal distance from where the ball last crossed the edge of the red penalty area.
4. Sprinkler heads and valves near the green: (Model Local Rule F-5) Player may take relief under Rule 16.1b if an immovable obstruction is on the line of play and is within two club lengths of the putting green and within two club lengths of the ball. No Penalty.
5. Out of Bounds: (Model Local Rule A-3, e.g. Hole \#11) A ball that comes to rest beyond the road, still on the course, is out of bounds. (Exceptions on Hole \#7 \& \#18)
6. Screen on \#17 Tee: Is deemed to be integral to the course. Unplayable ball relief is available (Rule 19.2). As an additional option the forward teeing area may be used as a drop zone. 1 stroke penalty.
